The Forge is a 2024 American Christian drama film directed by Alex Kendrick and co-written with his brother Stephen Kendrick. It serves as a spin-off to their 2015 film War Room. The story follows 19-year-old Isaiah Wright, portrayed by Aspen Kennedy. Isaiah is a recent high school graduate who spends his days playing basketball and video games, lacking direction and purpose. His single mother, Cynthia (Priscilla Shirer), frustrated with his aimlessness, gives him an ultimatum: find a job or move out. This push leads Isaiah to Moore Fitness, where he is hired by owner Joshua Moore (Cameron Arnett). Through Joshua's mentorship and guidance rooted in Christian faith, Isaiah embarks on a transformative journey, confronting personal challenges and discovering a deeper sense of responsibility and purpose. The Forge resonates with audiences seeking narratives about personal growth, faith, and the impact of

mentorship. Its exploration of a young man's journey to find meaning and direction offers an inspiring message about the transformative power of guidance and belief. (Adults can attend as well.)
